

Ladies Ski Club Picnic – Sunday June 10th

The walk will start at 10.30 and should take no more than 2½ hours. Total distance is 3.9 miles with an overall climb (then descent!) of 770 feet.

Meet from 10.00 on Jackson Lane (see below and 'Start' point on map).

Starting in Bollington the walk is low level through farmland to Rainow followed by a gentle climb to walk back along the saddle of Kerridge to White Nancy for a picnic lunch.

On a clear day there are magnificent views over the Cheshire Plain and Manchester to the west and the Peak District to the east.

Bring a packed lunch - tea and cakes will be on offer afterwards back at the Browns, 64 Manchester Road, Tytherington, Macclesfield, SK10 2JP.

Useful Information

Parking for the walk will be on Jackson Lane, Kerridge, just down from the Bull's Head (SK10 5BD) towards Bollington.

Walkers are welcome to park at the Browns and share a lift to the start of the walk, a 10-minute drive away.

Macclesfield is 1h 40m by train from London Euston.

By road: take Junction 17 off the M6 towards Congleton then leave Congleton on the A536 or travel across from the M1 via the A50, A52 and A523 through Ashbourne and Leek.
